



PSPR RESEARCH AND EDUCATION (RED) GRANT

The PSPR research and education grant, also known as the PSPR RED Grant, shall provide funding for innovative research and scholarly work from its members that have significant contribution and impact to the practice of pediatric radiology in the country. This grant shall also extend assistance to its members who shall be presenting their research works both locally and internationally. The grant shall also aid its members in publishing and dissemination of research materials, book projects, learning modules, educational reviews, video content and other scientifically relevant scholarly work. It is important to note that publication and dissemination may include, but are not limited to, print, audio, audiovisual, and multiple media.

All members in good standing may apply for the above grant provided they are able to fulfill and comply with the necessary requirements below. Projects must be PSPR-member-initiated. Applicants must not have received funding from other organizations or institutions, including sponsorships from pharmaceutical or medical device companies. The recipient shall disclose, as appropriate, that funding was provided by PSPR. The recipient shall also be asked to present the scientific output to the PSPR community during a forum, meeting, or a conference. PSPR shall be acknowledged as the fund grantor during the presentation and in the publication.

The research committee of PSPR shall review all applications for funding and present them to the PSPR Board of Trustees for approval. The amount granted may be in partial or in full, depending on the availability of funds and the decision of the Board. A memorandum of agreement between the recipient and PSPR shall be accomplished prior to releasing the funds requested.

REQUIREMENTS (in PDF format):

Research Seed Grant (RSG):

1. Duly accomplished application form
2. Letter of intent for sponsorship addressed to the head of the research committee of PSPR
3. Complete research proposal including the names of the investigators and their affiliations as well as the timetable (Gantt chart) and estimated financial expenses of the project (in PDF format).
4. Institutional ethical review approval
5. Periodic/Quarterly progress report (submitted within the duration of the project)

Research Presentation (Oral and Poster) Grant (RPG):

**N.B.: This grant shall only cover for the expenses of the presenting author/investigator.*

1. Duly accomplished application form
2. Letter of intent for sponsorship addressed to the head of the research committee of PSPR
3. Notice of acceptance of abstract/s in the intended convention
4. Proof of registration in the convention where the abstract/s is/are accepted
5. Copy of the research to be presented, whether in PDF or PPT format
6. Estimated financial expenses for the said presentation (including airfare, registration fee, and accommodations only)
7. Institutional ethical review approval

Research/Book/Educational Materials Publication Grant (REG):

1. Duly accomplished application form
2. Letter of intent for sponsorship addressed to the head of the research committee of PSPR, including the journal where the material is to be published
3. Copy of the research paper, book chapter, or educational material to be published in PDF format
4. Invitation letter or acceptance letter from the publisher or journal editor
5. Estimated cost of publication
6. Institutional ethical review approval

All grant recipients must submit the following, in PDF format, at the end of the project/presentation:

1. Detailed financial report with receipts where funding was used
2. Proof of attendance to the convention attended/presented at (including copies of certificate/s and pictures) and permission to use the pictures in the PSPR website for promotion and recognition
3. Final report detailing on the experience or progress of the research/publication and how the fund received has affected the outcome.
4. Copy of the final research project or published material.
